In Britain in 1912 there was a big difference between rich and poor people.



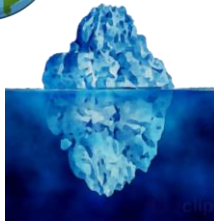
Etiquette was very important in Britain in 1912.

<u>29th July 1908</u> The design for the Titanic was approved.	<u>31st May 1911</u> The hull of the Titanic was successfully launched.	<u>January 1912</u> Sixteen wooden lifeboats were fitted on board the Titanic.	<u>2nd April 1912</u> The Titanic began sea trials.	<u>10th April 1912 Noon</u> The Titanic sets sail on her maiden voyage from Southampton to Cherbourg in France,	<u>11th April 1912</u> The Titanic reaches Queenstown, Ireland.	<u>12th -13th April 1912</u> The Titanic sails through calm waters.	<u>14th April 1912</u> Lookout Fredrick Fleet spots an iceberg. The Titanic hits the iceberg.	<u>15th April 1912</u> The Carpathia, 58 miles away starts to sail to help them.	<u>18th April 1912</u> The Carpathia arrives in New York with 705 survivors.
