

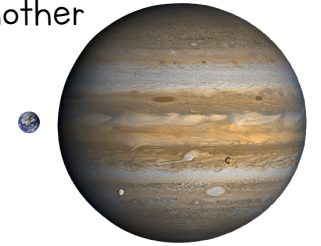


Year 5 Space

What I should know:

✧ **Scale** is the size of an object compared to another object.

(The size of Earth compared to Jupiter.)



✧ **Proportion** is how one part of an object compares to the whole object.

(The size of Saturn compared to its rings.)

Space Exploration	The use of astronomy and space technology to explore outer space.
Telescope	A telescope is an instrument that allows people to see distant objects. Telescopes are important tools in astronomy, or the study of planets, stars, and other objects in outer space.
Nebula	A nebula is a giant cloud of dust and gas in space.
Texture	The feel or appearance of a surface.
Smudge	To cause something to become messily smeared by rubbing it.
Spread	To cover a surface with a substance in an even layer.
Finger Painting	Painting using your fingers.
Blend	Combine one colour with another.
Defined	Make the outline clear.
