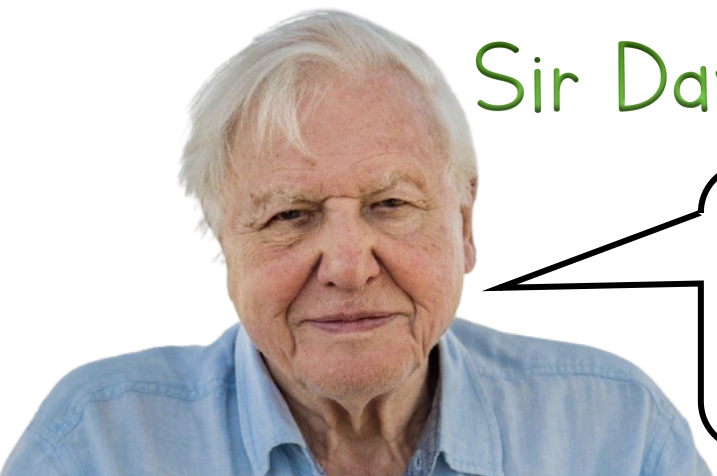


Key Vocabulary	
Animal	Any living creature with senses that can move from place to place independently.
Birth	The process of bearing young; when a baby animal comes out of an egg or out of its mother.
Breeding	The mating of animals and the production of offspring.
Endangered	A species seriously at risk of extinction.
Metamorphosis	The process of transforming from a miniature into an adult animal.
Incomplete Metamorphosis	The nymph resembles a miniature adult.
Complete Metamorphosis	The egg, larva and pupa look completely different to the grown adult.
Nymph	A miniature form of an insect that does not change as it grows.
Life cycle	The series of changes occurring in an animal or plant.




#### Mammals

- Are warm-blooded.

- Produce milk for their young.



#### Amphibian

- Hatch in water with gills and develop lungs.
- Go through metamorphosis.



#### Insects

- Have an exoskeleton.
- Their body is in 3 parts: head, thorax and abdomen.
- Go through incomplete metamorphosis or complete metamorphosis.

#### Birds

- Have two legs and two wings.
- Are covered with feathers.
- Lay eggs with hard shells.
- Are warm-blooded with a skeleton inside their body.
